RACE START TIMES

2.5km start: 9:00am 1.2km start: 10:30am

Allow at least 30 minutes to walk to the start/marshalling zone from the registration check-in area in front of the lifesaving club.

PARKING

Parking is available in the Dendy Pavilion / Brighton Life Saving Club car park, at Green Point, Brighton Baths and along Beach Road. There may be some spots in surrounding streets - please read & respect parking signs. Payment may be required at some sites.

MEDALS

Medals will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd male and female in the 2.5km swim and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd male and female in each age category in the 1.2km Classic swim.

SAFETY

Please ensure you have trained and are fit for the swim/s you have chosen. Water safety and first aid will be on hand throughout the event. Should you require assistance during the swim, raise your arm above your head and signal for help, float on your back and wait for a water safety team member to assist you. If you leave the water prior to finishing, please take your race timing tag to the finish area as soon as possible.

RULES

General: The spirit of friendly competition should be maintained throughout the event. Unsporting conduct may result in disqualification. Decisions of the event officials are final and not subject to appeal.

SWIM

- No extraneous aids are permitted. This includes, but is not limited to fins, boards, snorkels and floatation gear
- Wetsuits are permissible
- Goggles are recommended
- Once the race has commenced, competitors are not to touch land until they have proceeded through the marker flags, positioned at the finish area
- Swimmers are required to wear an official timing device and swim cap supplied on registration
- Organisers reserve the right to accept, reject or cancel entries
- All swimmers in the 1.2km & 2.5km events must confirm when they register that they are physically capable of completing the event safely and in reasonable time
- Swimmers must swim the course as marked and described on the course map. Any variation will be announced at the start
- Race officials shall have the ultimate authority to remove a competitor from the race if the competitor is judged to be physically incapable of continuing the race without the risk of injury
- Protests must be made in writing and given to the Race Judge within 15 minutes of the announcement of the provisional results. All decisions of the Race Director are final
